On September 9, 2002, Loren Finley filed a petition for investigation of a question concerning representation with the Public Employment Relations Commission under Chapter 391-25 WAC. The petition did not indicate the name of the union seeking certification and was not accompanied by a showing of interest conforming to WAC 391-25-110.

A letter was sent to the petitioner on September 13, 2002, noting the defect that prevented further processing of the case. In particular, it was pointed out that WAC 391-25-110 requires that a showing of interest must consist of original or legible copies of individual cards or letters signed and dated by employees in the bargaining unit claimed appropriate.

The petitioner was given a period of ten days in which to show cause why the petition should not be dismissed. The petitioner did not respond within the allotted time and therefore, the petition must be dismissed.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

The petition for investigation of a question concerning representation filed in the above captioned matter is DISMISSED.
