Brian O'Sullivan, a nonsupervisory employee, appeared pro se.

On March 29, 2007, Brian O'Sullivan and Dennis Redmon each filed a petition for investigation of a question concerning representation with the Public Employment Relations Commission, seeking to decertify the Washington Public Employees Association (WPEA) as exclusive bargaining representative of certain employees at the Washington State Department of Revenue.

Both petitions were accompanied by copies of nearly the same authorization cards. Thus, both petitions raised the same issues with respect to the adequacy of the showing of interest. On April 23, 2007, a deficiency notice was issued to both petitioners providing each an opportunity to respond to the deficiency notice by May 8, 2007. Due to an administrative oversight, the response of Redmon was overlooked and both petitions were dismissed on May 9, 2007. The Order of Dismissal was subsequently revoked on May

10, 2007, so that the Executive Director could review the response to the deficiency notice and make a determination based upon the merits.

O'Sullivan did not respond to the deficiency notice. Although Redmon responded to the deficiency notice and claimed that his response pertained to both petitions, there is no evidence that O'Sullivan authorized Redmon to act on his behalf. No designation of representative or notice of appearance was filed by any other individual on O'Sullivan's behalf.¹

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

The petition in Case 20995-E-07-3244 is dismissed due to the petitioner's failure to respond to the deficiency notice.
