On May 14, 1998, International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 3219 (union), filed a petition with the Public Employment Relations Commission under Chapter 391-35 WAC, seeking clarification of an existing bargaining unit of employees of the Marysville Fire District (employer). A hearing was opened before Hearing Officer Jack T. Cowan on December 16, 1998. At the outset of the hearing, the parties requested that the hearing be continued, so that they could explore settlement of the dispute. The Hearing Officer agreed to the continuation, but the parties have neither submitted a settlement agreement or requested further proceedings.

On July 6, 1999, the parties were given 14 days to show cause why the case should not be cleared from the Commission's docket of pending cases. On July 12, 1999, the employer informed the Hearing Officer that the matter had been resolved. Nothing was heard or received from the union.


NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

The petition for unit clarification filed in the above-captioned matter is DISMISSED for lack of prosecution.
