SEIU District 1199 NW filed a petition seeking clarification of an existing bargaining unit of employees of King County Public Hospital District No. 1, with respect to the bargaining unit status of the position of "Fitness Techs." In response to a deficiency notice issued by the Commission, the union filed an amended petition. The employer responded to the amendment by filing a motion to dismiss for failure to properly serve the petition.

On August 24, 2005, a letter was sent to the union stating that the employer properly stated the law on the issue of service and requiring the union to file appropriate documentation to show that it had, in fact, served copies of the amended complaint on the employer. The union was given seven days to provide the required documentation. To date, the union has not filed any further documents concerning this case. Accordingly, the petition must be dismissed because the union has not completed its service obligation.

The petition filed in the above-captioned matter is hereby DISMISSED.
