FINDINGS OF FACT

- Teamsters Local 760 filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission a petition concerning representation of employees of the City of Cashmere. The petition was timely filed and was accompanied by a showing of interest administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient. No other organization is known to claim to represent the employees involved.
- 2. These representation proceedings were conducted by the Commission in the bargaining unit described as:

All full-time and regular part-time employees of the City of Cashmere in the Light Department, Water/Waste Water Department, Street Department, Parks and Cemetery Department, Sanitation Department, Equipment Department, and office-clerical employees, excluding elected officials, supervisors, confidential employees, temporary employees, seasonal employees, volunteers, and all other employees.

3. All proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in the selection of a bargaining representative, if any; a confidential cross-check of employer and union documents has been conducted by Commission staff and a tally of the results previously furnished to the parties is attached hereto; and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The unit described in paragraph 2 of the foregoing Findings of Fact is an appropriate unit for the purpose of collective bargaining within the meaning of RCW 41.56.060.
- 2. All conditions precedent to a certification have been met.

CERTIFIED

The employees of the City of Cashmere in the appropriate bargaining unit described in paragraph 2 of the foregoing Findings of Fact have chosen:

TEAMSTERS LOCAL 760

as their representative for the purpose of collective bargaining with their employer.
