FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 77 filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission a petition concerning representation of employees of the City of Seattle. The petition was timely filed and was accompanied by a showing of interest administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient. No other organization is known to claim or represent the employees involved.
- 2. These representation proceedings were conducted by the Commission in the bargaining unit described as:

All regular full-time and regular part-time Power Marketers employed by Seattle City Light, excluding supervisors, confidential employees, and all other employees.

3. All proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in the selection of a bargaining representative, if any; a confidential cross-check of employer and union documents has been conducted by Commission staff and a tally of the results previously furnished to the parties is attached hereto; and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The unit described in paragraph 2 of the foregoing Findings of Fact is an appropriate unit for the purpose of collective bargaining within the meaning of RCW 41.56.060.
- 2. All conditions precedent to a certification have been met.
