FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The above-named petitioner filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission a petition for investigation of a question concerning representation of employees of the above-named employer. The petition was timely filed and accompanied bv a showing of interest which was administratively determined by the Commission to sufficient. No other organization is known to claim to represent the employees involved.
- 2. These representation proceedings were conducted by the Commission in the bargaining unit described as:
 - ALL FULL-TIME AND REGULAR PART-TIME FACILITY SERVICES EMPLOYEES IN THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON BOTHELL CAMPUS, EXCLUDING SUPERVISORS, CONFIDENTIAL EMPLOYEES, OFFICE-CLERICAL EMPLOYEES, SKILLED TRADES EMPLOYEES AND ALL OTHER EMPLOYEES.
- 3. All proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in the selection of their bargaining representative, a confidential cross-check of employer and union documents has been conducted by the Commission staff and a tally of the results previously furnished to the parties is attached hereto; and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

- 1. The unit described in paragraph 2 of the foregoing Findings of Fact is an appropriate unit for the purposes of collective bargaining within the meaning of 41.80 RCW.
- 2. All conditions precedent to a certification have been met.
