**UNIT:** All Key punch Operators and Senior Key punch Operators employed by the City of Seattle, Washington.

The above employees are to be accreted into existing Technical Unit as outlined in Appendix B of the Agreement between the International Federation of Professional and Technical Engineers, Local 17, and the City of Seattle dated March 19, 1976.
