- 1. The above-named petitioner timely filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission a petition for investigation of a question concerning representation of employees of the above-named employer; said petition was accompanied by a showing of interest which was administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient; and the employer declined voluntarily to extend recognition to the petitioner as the exclusive bargaining representative of its employees.
- 2. These representation proceedings were conducted by the Commission in the bargaining unit described as:

ALL FULL-TIME AND REGULAR PART-TIME NON-SUPERVISORY PROFESSIONAL AND TECHNICAL EMPLOYEES OF RITZVILLE MEMORIAL HOSPITAL; EXCLUDING SUPERVISORS, CONFIDENTIAL EMPLOYEES, OFFICE-CLERICAL EMPLOYEES, MAINTENANCE EMPLOYEES, FOOD SERVICE EMPLOYEES, AND STUDENTS.

3. All proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in these election of their bargaining representative, if any; a tally of the results was previously furnished to the parties and is attached hereto; and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.
