FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Sandra Bolt filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission a representation petition concerning the representation of employees of the above-named employer. The petition was timely filed and was accompanied by a showing of interest which was administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient.
- 2. AFT Washington is the incumbent labor organization that represented the petitioned-for employees and was granted status as intervenor in this proceeding.
- 3. These representation proceedings were conducted by the Commission in the bargaining unit described as:

All employees of the Seattle Community Colleges who are exempt from Chapter 41.06 RCW and covered by RCW 41.56.021(1), excluding employees excluded by RCW 41.56.021(1)(a) through (e), employees subject to Chapter 41.80 RCW, and all other employees..

4. All proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in the selection of their bargaining representative, if any; a tally of the results previously furnished to the parties is attached hereto; and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The unit described in paragraph 3 of the foregoing Findings of Fact is an appropriate unit for the purposes of collective bargaining within the meaning of RCW 41.56.060.

2. All conditions precedent to a certification have been met.
