Pursuant to authority vested in the undersigned by Washington State Statutes, IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that Renton Association of Supervisors and Administrators

has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the above-named Employer, in the unit described below, as their representative for the purpose of collective bargaining, and that the said organization is the exclusive representative of all the employees in such unit for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, wages, hours of employment, and other conditions of employment.

UNIT: INCLUDED: The following Administrators/Supervisors shall be included in the bargaining unit: Speech/Hearing Program Head; Music Specialist; Library Specialist; Nurses Program Head; Administrative Assistant; Director Pupil Programs; Language Arts. Foreign Language and Reading Coordinator; Instructional Materials Coordinator; Area Administrator/Instructional Program Coordinator; Pupil Services Coordinator; Personnel Specialist; Area Administrator/Curriculum Development Coordinator; Activities, Health, P. E. and Recreation Coordinator; Sartori Program Head; Learning Center Program Head; Helping Center Program Head; Acting Vocational Supervisor; and Vocational Supervisors.

EXCLUDED: Curriculum/Instruction Specialist; Mathematics Specialist; Health/Recreation/P.E. Specialist; and the Supervisor/Instructor.
