FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The above-named Petitioner timely filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission a petition for investigation of a question concerning representation of employees of the above-named employer; said petition was accompanied by a showing of interest which was administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient; and the employer declined voluntarily to extend recognition to the Petitioner as the exclusive bargaining representataive of its employees.
- 2. The organization(s) listed above as exclusive bargaining representative timely moved for intervention in the captioned proceedings; and said motion for intervention was in each case supported by a showing of interest which was administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient.
- 3. These representation proceedings were conducted by the Commission in the bargaining unit described as:

All full-time and regular part-time employees engaged in the operation of visual and audio equipment at the Kingdome, excluding supervisors, confidential employees, and all other employees of the employer.
