FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Washington State Council of County and City Employees filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission a petition concerning representation of employees of Cowlitz County. The petition was timely filed and was accompanied by a showing of interest administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient.
- 2. The Probation Employees Association is the incumbent labor organization that represented the petitioned-for employees.
- 3. These representation proceedings were conducted by the Commission in the bargaining unit described as:

All full-time and regular part-time employees of Cowlitz County Adult Parole and Probation, excluding supervisors, confidential employees, and all other employees.

4. All proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in the selection of their bargaining representative, if any; a tally of the results previously furnished to the parties is attached hereto; and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The unit described in paragraph 3 of the foregoing Findings of Fact is an appropriate unit for the purpose of collective bargaining within the meaning of RCW 41.56.060.
- 2. All conditions precedent to a certification have been met.
