3. These representation proceedings were conducted by the Commission in the bargaining unit described as:
INCLUDED: All the employees in the following departments: Medical records, fiscal services, central supply, maintenance, laundry, housekeeping, dietary, laboratory, radiology, pharmacy, and nursing services.
EXCLUDED: Administrative secretary, supervisors, registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, and all other employees of the employer.

All proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in the selection of their bargaining representative, if any; a tally of the results was previously furnished to the parties and is attached hereto; and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
The unit described in finding of fact number 3 is an appropriate unit for the purposes of collective bargaining within the meaning of RCW $\underline{41.56}$; and all conditions precedent to a certification have been met.
NOW, THEREFORE, it is CERTIFIED
The majority of the employees of the above named employer employed in the appropriate collective bargaining unit described in finding of fact number 3 have chosen:
