A representation proceedings, as indicated above, having been conducted under the supervision of the Public Employment Relations Comm. and it appearing from the results that a collective bargaining representative has been selected; and no objections having been filed to the proceedings therefor;

Pursuant to authority vested in the undersigned by Washington State Statutes, IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that Service Employees International Union. Local 120

has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the above-named Employer, in the unit described below, as their representative for the purpose of collective bargaining, and that the said organization is the exclusive representative of all the employees in such unit for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to rates of pay, wages, hours of employment, and other conditions of employment.

UNIT: INCLUDED: All employees of the employer including all employees employed in the following classifications: physical therapy aides, physical therapists, laboratory technologists and technicians, respiratory therapy technicians, cardio-pulmonary technicians, dietary workers, cooks, housekeeping aides, assistant to chief engineers, engineering assistants, engineering trainees, bus drivers, groundskeepers, receiving and distributing clerks, nursing assistants, ward secretaries, central service technicians, medical records transcriptionists, records technicians, clerk typists, posting machine operators, patient accounts coordinators, admitting clerks and receptionists.

EXCLUDED: Employees covered by other collective bargaining contracts (RNs, LPNs, and radiology technicians), supervisory employees, confidential employees and casual employees.
