All full-time and regular part-time clerical and related employees of the City of Ocean Shores, excluding elected officials, confidential employees and supervisors, and all other employees of the employer.

All proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in the selection of their bargaining representative, if any; a tally of the results
