FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Public School Employees of Washington filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission a petition concerning representation of the Secretary Senior and Library & Archives Paraprofessional job classes at the Lynnwood Campus of Central Washington University. The petition was timely filed and accompanied by a showing of interest administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient. No other organization is known to claim to represent the employees involved.
- 2. The existing bargaining unit represented by the Public School Employees of Washington is described as:

All classified employees whose primary duty station is the Des Moines Campus of Central Washington University except TV/video equipment operators, faculty, administrative exempt employees, confidential employees, supervisors, and all other employees of the employer.

3. All proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in the selection of whether they wished to be represented by the Public School Employees of Washington in its existing bargaining unit. A confidential cross-check of employer and union documents has been conducted by Commission staff and a tally of the results previously furnished to the parties is attached hereto, and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.

4. The existing bargaining unit represented by the Public School Employees of Washington shall be modified to include the Secretary Senior and Library & Archives Paraprofessional job classes for a bargaining unit described as:

All classified employees employed at the Des Moines Campus and Lynnwood Campus of Central Washington University, excluding supervisory employees, confidential employees, employees performing work in the Media Maintenance Technician Lead and TV/Video Equipment Operator job classes, faculty, administrative exempt employees, and all other employees of the employer.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The unit described in paragraph 4 of the foregoing Findings of Fact is an appropriate unit for the purpose of collective bargaining within the meaning of RCW 41.80.070.
- 2. All conditions precedent to a certification have been met.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

CERTIFIED

The Secretary Senior and Library & Archives Paraprofessional job classes at the Lynnwood Campus of Central Washington University have chosen:

PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEES OF WASHINGTON

as their representative for the purpose of collective bargaining with their employer.
