ORDER OF DISMISSAL

MEDICAL LAKE EDUCATION ASSOCIATION

AND

MEDICAL LAKE SCHOOL DISTRICT

On November 29, 1979, Kathy Work filed documents with the Public Employment Relations Commission seeking a ruling on her obligations under a union security agreement. The documents submitted indicated that a claim had been advanced by the petitioner that she was entitled to assert a right of non-association based on bona fide religious tenets or teachings of a church or religious body of which she was a member, and that the Medical Lake Education Association had declined to accede to her claim. Subsequent investigation of the matter by a member of the Commission staff disclosed that the petitioner is no longer an employee of the Medical Lake School District and that no funds are being held in escrow under RCW 41.59.100 and rules of the Commission. Those investigation results were brought to the attention of the parties by letter dated October 23, 1980, wherein the Petitioner was given a ten day period within which to make a written request for further proceedings in this matter or be dismissed. No communication was received from the Petitioner within the indicated period or the three additional days allowed pursuant to WAC 391-08-103.

NOW, THEREFORE, It is

## ORDERED

The petition filed in the above entitled matter is dismissed for lack of prosecution.
