If no petition for review of this order is filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission within twenty (20) days following the date of this order, Spokane School District shall thereafter remit to Spokane Education Association in accordance with WAC 391-95-310, any and all funds withheld and retained pursuant to WAC 391-95-130 from the pay of David W. Dengler.
