On October 28, 1991, David Cordaro filed a petition with the Public Employment Relations Commission pursuant to Chapter 391-95 WAC, seeking a ruling concerning his obligations under union security provisions of a collective bargaining agreement between City of Seattle and the District Council of Carpenters, Local 131. The Executive Director issued a preliminary ruling in the matter pursuant to WAC 391-95-150, finding that the petition framed a dispute within the jurisdiction of the Commission. Examiner Katrina I. Boedecker of the Commission staff was subsequently assigned to process the petition.

In telephonic contacts with the petitioner and the union, the Examiner was advised that the parties were attempting to settle the dispute. In March of 1993, the parties advised the Commission, by telephone, that they had resolved all contested issues raised in the petition. A written withdrawal of the petition was not forthcoming from the parties, however.

On April 8, 1993, the parties were directed to show cause why the petition should not be dismissed for lack of any issue within the jurisdiction of the Commission. Nothing further has been heard or received from the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

The petition for ruling on union security obligations filed in the above-captioned matter is hereby DISMISSED.
