On January 17, 1978, a petition was filed with the Commission and docketed as Case No. 1338-E-78-265, seeking decertification of IS-SKA-WHA Socio-Economic Committee as the representative of radiological technologists employed by Whidbey General Hospital. Both petitions relate to a multi-employer bargaining unit certified by the Washington State Department of Labor and Industries covering Whidbey General Hospital, Island Hospital, Skagit Valley Hospital and United General Hospital. Case No. 0-1346, October 3, 1973. The organization has previously disclaimed representation rights with respect to United General Hospital. On February 14, 1978, the Commission received correspondence from the IS-SKA-WHA Socio-Economic Committee, indicating that the organization disclaims all bargaining rights in the multi-employer bargaining unit in which it was previously certified, and that the organization is to be discontinued. - 1 -

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED 1. The certification of representatives issued by the Washington State Department of Labor and Industries in Case No. 0-1346 is withdrawn. 2. The petitions filed in the above-entitled matters are dismissed on the basis that no question concerning representation presently exists.
