### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The above-named petitioner timely filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission a petition for investigation of a question concerning representation of employees of the above-named employer; said petition was accompanied by a showing of interest which was administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient; and the employer declined voluntarily to extend recognition to the petitioner as the exclusive bargaining representative of its employees.
- 2. These representation proceedings were conducted by the Commission in the bargaining unit described as:

ALL FULL-TIME AND REGULAR PART-TIME OFFICE-CLERICAL, SOCIAL WORK, RESPIRATORY THERAPY, OPERATION ROOM TECHNICIAN, AND TECHNICIAN EMPLOYEES AND ALL FULL-TIME AND REGULAR PART-TIME EMPLOYEES IN THE RADIOLOGY, DIETARY, PURCHASING, HOUSEKEEPING, LAUNDRY, MAINTENANCE, PHARMACY AND CENTRAL SUPPLY DEPARTMENT: EXCLUDING ALL EMPLOYEES PERFORMING THE DUTIES REGISTERED NURSES, LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSES, NURSES AIDES, MANAGEMENT, SUPERVISORS,

CONFIDENTIAL EMPLOYEES, AND PER DIEM/ON-CALL EMPLOYEES.

3. All proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in these election of their bargaining representative, if any; a tally of the results was previously furnished to the parties and is attached hereto; and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.

#### CONCLUSION OF LAW

The unit described in finding of fact number 2 is an appropriate unit for the purposes of collective bargaining within the meaning of RCW 41.56; and all conditions precedent to a certification have been met.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is
