ORDER CLOSING CASE

The above-captioned proceeding was initiated by a petition for investigation of a question concerning representation filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission on September 21, 1992, by International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 286. The case was consolidated for processing with Case 10013-E-92-1641, a representation petition concerning the same bargaining unit filed with the Commission on September 18, 1992, by the Washington State Council of County and City Employees (WSCCCE).

The Commission conducted a representation election under both case numbers, with both organizations on the ballot. The tally of ballots issued at the conclusion of that election indicated that a majority of the employees favored the WSCCCE. No objections were filed, and an interim certification was issued in the companion case, designating the WSCCCE as the exclusive bargaining representative of the petitioned-for employees.

The Executive Director has considered the matter and concludes that no case or controversy remains to be decided in this proceeding, so that the closure of the case is warranted.

## ORDERED

The proceedings on the petition for investigation of a question concerning representation filed by International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 286, shall be, and hereby are, CLOSED.
