ORDER CLOSING CASE

The Washington State Council of County and City Employees filed a petition with the Public Employment Relations Commission on July 23, 1982, seeking certification as exclusive bargaining representative of a bargaining unit of supervisory employees of the Snohomish County Department of Public Works. The parties subsequently filed an election agreement and an election was conducted by the Commission, leading to the issuance on October 14, 1983 of interim certification of the union as exclusive bargaining an representative, subject to determination of certain eligibility issues. А hearing scheduled for January 10, 1984 was continued at the request of the union. On March 29, 1984, the union disclaimed all representation rights in the matter.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

## ORDERED

- The interim certification of Washington State Council of County and City Employees as exclusive bargaining representative, issued as Decision 1767 PECB on October 14, 1983, is withdrawn.
- 2. The petition for investigation of a question concerning representation filed in the above-entitled matter is dismissed.
