A Direction of Election having been issued in the above-entitled matter on April 7, 1982 as Decision No. 1418 - PECB; and errors having been discovered therein; and the Executive Director having considered the matter, and being satisfied that the errors must be corrected before further proceeding with the case:

NOW, THEREFORE,

1. In the first paragraph of the Discussion on page 4, the date in the citation to Snoqualmie School District is corrected to "(PECB, 1978)".
2. The Direction of Election is corrected as follows:

DIRECTION OF ELECTION

1. A unit determination election by secret ballot shall be held under the direction of the Public Employment Relations Commission in the following voting group:

All secretarial-clerical employees of North Thurston School District No. 3, excluding Secretary to the Superintendent, Secretary to the Associate Superintendent and Secretary to Administrator of Personnel.

to determine whether a majority of employees eligible to vote desire to constitute themselves a separate bargaining unit of secretarial-clerical employees.

2. Conditioned on the outcome of the unit determination election directed above, a representation election shall be held under the direction of the Public Employment Relations Commission as follows:

In the event that a majority of those eligible to vote in the voting group described in paragraph 1 vote in favor of creation of a separate bargaining unit of secretarial-clerical employees, an election by secret ballot shall be held under the direction of the Public Employment Relations Commission among all secretarial-clerical employees of the district, excluding Secretary to the Superintendent, Secretary to the Associate Superintendent and Secretary to Administrator of Personnel, to determine whether a majority of these employees desire to be represented by Classified Public Employees Association, WEA/NEA; by Washington State Council of County and City Employees, Local 618, AFL-CIO, or by no representative.
