These proceedings were initiated by a representation petition filed on September 23, 1986. A representation election was conducted by the Commission on December 22, 1986. An interim certification was issued on December 30, 1986, designating the petitioner as exclusive bargaining representative for a bargaining unit described as:

All regular full-time employees of Douglas County Public Works Department in the maintenance technician, leadman, engineering technician, and secretarial job classifications; excluding the director, deputy director, road engineer, confidential employees, supervisors and all other employees of the employer.

Douglas County, Decision 2590 (PECB, 1986).

At the time the interim certification was issued, the employer and the petitioner disagreed as to the bargaining unit placement of two employees holding titles of "Secretary/Receptionist" and "Assistant Office Manager/Bookkeeper". During the course of ensuing correspondence, the parties stipulated, in writing, to the exclusion of the secretary/receptionist from the bargaining unit. Indicating that the assistant office manager/bookkeeper

position was to be re-titled as "Assistant Office Manager" and given new responsibilities, the parties reported to the Hearing Officer that there was no longer any dispute about that position.

On May 27, 1987, the Executive Director issued a letter to the parties, detailing the then-current information and informing the parties that, unless good cause was shown on or before June 11, 1987, the issues reserved for further proceedings would be deemed resolved on the basis of the parties filed or reported stipulations, and the case would be closed. The parties have not filed any additional documents, nor have they requested an extension of time for the filing of their responses. The matter thus appears to be resolved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

1. The certification of bargaining representative issued in Douglas County, Decision 2590 (PECB,1986) shall stand as the final certification in the above-captioned matter.
2. The above-captioned case is closed.
