Robert P. Donovan filed a petition with the Public Employment Relations Commission on November 14, 1988, seeking decertification of Teamsters Local 882 from its status as the exclusive bargaining representative of marina attendants employed by the Port of Seattle. By order dated July 18, 1989, 1 it was determined that a question concerning representation exists. An election was directed in a bargaining unit described as:

All full-time and regular part-time marina attendants, excluding confidential employees, supervisors and all other employees of the employer.

Notice was issued on August 7, 1989, setting a representation election to be conducted by mail ballot beginning August 16, 1989.

By letter dated August 9, 1989, and filed with the Commission on August 11, 1989, Teamsters Local 882 disclaimed all representation rights in the bargaining unit involved in these proceedings. The union acknowledged in the disclaimer letter that it will be barred

by WAC 391-25-450<sup>2</sup> from seeking to be certified in this bargaining unit for a period of at least one year.

The Executive Director has considered the matter and is satisfied that there remains no question concerning representation to be determined in the above-captioned proceedings.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

## **ORDERED**

The petition filed in the above-entitled matter is dismissed for lack of a question concerning representation.
