- 1. - 2. The organization(s) listed above as intervenors timely moved for intervention in the captioned proceedings; and said motion for intervention was in each case supported by a showing of interest which as administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient.
- 3. These representation proceedings were conducted by the Commission in the bargaining unit described as:

ALL REGULAR FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME UNIFORMED EMPLOYEES OF THE EMPLOYER; EXCLUDING FIRE CHIEF, NON-UNIFORMED, AND CONFIDENTIAL.

any; a tally of the results was previously furnished to the parties and is attached hereto; and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.
