On February 17, 1999, Teamsters Union, Local 252 filed a petition for investigation of a question concerning representation with the Public Employment Relations Commission, involving certain employees of Lewis County. As a result of preliminary processing of the petition, the Commission proceeded with determination of the question concerning representation, and issues concerning the eligibility of certain employees for inclusion in the bargaining unit were reserved for subsequent determination. The tally indicated that Teamsters Union, Local 252 was entitled to certification in the matter, and that the reserved eligibility issues were not of a sufficient number to affect the outcome of the proceedings.

An interim certification was issued in this matter, as <u>Lewis</u> <u>County</u>, Decision 6663 (PECB, 1999).

The proceeding was held open to resolve the eligibility disputes previously framed by the parties. The parties filed a memorandum of agreement on July 6, 1999, but the terms used in a proposed unit description were found to contravene Commission practice. The parties were given a period of time to show cause why a unit description conforming the Commission practice should not be used. Neither party responded.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

## **ORDERED**

The interim certification issued in this matter will stand as the final certification in this representation proceeding, except that the unit description is amended to read as follows:

ALL FULL-TIME AND REGULAR PART-TIME ACCOUNTING AND OFFICE-CLERICAL EMPLOYEES OF THE LEWIS COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, EXCLUDING SUPERVISORS, CONFIDENTIAL EMPLOYEES, AND ALL OTHER EMPLOYEES.

2. The above-captioned matter is CLOSED.
