DECISION ON MOTION FOR DISCRETIONARY REVIEW

Julie Henning, appeared pro se.

Robert W. Ferguson, Attorney General, by *Patricia A. Thompson*, Assistant Attorney General, for the employer.

The Washington Public Employees Association (WPEA) filed a motion pursuant to WAC 391-25-390 requesting the Commission to review Executive Director Michael P. Sellars' decision denying the WPEA's motion to dismiss a decertification petition.<sup>1</sup>

On March 19, 2013, the WPEA moved to dismiss the decertification petition filed by Julie Henning (Henning). The Executive Director ruled that the employer's conduct did not warrant dismissal of the representation petition. The Executive Director lifted the blocking charge<sup>2</sup> and remanded the case to the Representation Case Administrator for further processing.

Columbia Basin College, Decision 11776 (PSRA, 2013).

WPEA had previously filed an unfair labor practice complaint alleging employer interference with employee rights. The Examiner's decision was affirmed by the Commission. *Columbia Basin College*, Decision 11609-A (PSRA, 2013). After compliance, the unfair labor practice charge would no longer block processing of the decertification petition. WAC 391-25-370.

On June 17, 2013, the WPEA filed a motion for discretionary review under WAC 391-25-390. The union alleged that the Executive Director committed probable error, that the decision alters the status quo by subjecting the union to a decertification vote when the petition was tainted by the employer's unlawful conduct. The union requested the Commission to accept discretionary review.

On June 28, 2013, the employer filed a response. The employer asserts that WPEA's motion is premature. The employer argues that the Executive Director's ruling is an interim ruling and WAC 391-25-590, not WAC 391-25-390(4), is the applicable rule.

The Commission has reviewed the motion. The union's motion for discretionary review is denied. The case is remanded to the Representation Case Administrator for further processing.

The Motion for Discretionary Review is denied.
