Following is an excerpt from the minutes of the commission meeting held on July 14, 1978:

"Motion for temporary relief made pursuant to WAC 391-30-560."

"This motion was filed by the Olympia School District, which was represented at the meeting by Otto Klein. represented the Lonnquist Olvmpia Education Association. Both parties argued their positions at length and responded to questions from the Commission. The Commission then took a short recess to reach a decision. At the conclusion of the recess, Chairman Krug announced that the commission had decided to ask the Attorney General to proceed to move in the Superior Court for an injunction pendente <u>lite</u> to compel the bargaining agents for the Olympia Education Association to resume bargaining with the Olympia School District forthwith. Commissioner Beck and Commissioner Roberts affirmed their concurrence with the decision."
