ORDER OF REMAND

DECISION NO. 25A-PECB

This matter is before the Commission on appeal from an order of the authorized agent dismissing unfair labor practice charges filed by the Union alleging a refusal to bargain by the City. The basis for dismissal was that the positions involved were "managerial".

In light of the declaratory ruling entered by the Commission in City of Tacoma, Case No. 135-DRW-047, Decision No. 95A-PECB (3/77), that determination by the authorized agent must be reversed and the matter must be remanded for further proceedings under the rules of the Commission now in effect.

NOW THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

The order of the authorized agent dismissing the unfair labor practice charges filed in the above entitled matter is reversed and the matter is remanded to the Executive Director for further proceedings under the rules of the Commission now in effect.
