ORDER CLOSING CASE

Perkins, Coie, by <u>Lawrence B. Hannah</u>, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the employer.

Wayman N. Alston, Business Representative, appeared on behalf of the union.

On December 3, 1987, Snohomish County Health District (petitioner or employer) filed a petition for clarification of an existing bargaining unit of its employees represented by International Federation of Professional and Technical Engineers, Local 17 (union). The petitioner sought to exclude three positions as supervisory. The positions at issue were titled Laboratory Director, Supervisor of the Food Section, and Supervisor of the Water and Liquid Waste Section.

A hearing was convened, pursuant to notice, on June 29, 1988. At the outset of the hearing, the parties advised the Hearing Officer that they had reached agreement on the disposition of the disputed positions. Their stipulation that the positions at issue should be excluded from the bargaining unit as

supervisors was entered into the record and the hearing was then closed.

Examination of the case file and the record made indicates that further proceedings are not necessary. Having noted the stipulation entered by the parties, it is hereby:

The proceedings in Case No. 7162-C-87-383 are hereby CLOSED.
