By petition filed on November 21, 1996, Seattle Education Association (petitioner) seeks inclusion of employees designated as Student Placement Coordinators in a unit of paraprofessionals employed by the Seattle School district (employer).

The matter was scheduled for hearing on June 11, 1997, before Hearing Officer Vincent M. Helm. The employer, by letter dated May 14, 1997, advised the Hearing Officer that it did not oppose the relief sought by the petitioner and, therefore, would not attend the scheduled hearing.

In view of the foregoing and it appearing that the inclusion of the classification sought in the petition would conform with Commission criteria it is hereby:

ORDERED

1. The student placement coordinators are included in the para-professionals bargaining unit.
2. These procedures are CLOSED.
