FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Teamsters, Local 763 filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission a petition concerning representation of employees of the Port of Seattle. The petition was timely filed and accompanied by a showing of interest administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient.
- 2. These representation proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in the bargaining unit described as:

All full-time and regular part-time employees in the Landside Supervisor job class working in the Public Parking, Employee Parking, and Ground Transportation groups in the Landside Department of the Port of Seattle, excluding non-supervisory employees, confidential employees, and all other employees.

3. All proceedings were conducted in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in the selection of a bargaining representative, if any; a tally of the results previously furnished to the parties is attached hereto; and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The unit described in Finding of Fact 2 is an appropriate unit for the purpose of collective bargaining within the meaning of RCW 41.56.060.
- 2. All conditions precedent to a certification have been met.

CERTIFICATION

The employees of the Port of Seattle in the appropriate bargaining unit described in Finding of Fact 2 have chosen

TEAMSTERS, LOCAL 763

as their representative for the purpose of collective bargaining with their employer.
