FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. United Food and Commercial Workers, Local 21 filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission a petition concerning representation of the security employees at Jefferson Healthcare. The petition was timely filed and accompanied by a showing of interest administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient. No other organization is known to claim to represent the employees involved.
- 2. The existing bargaining unit represented by United Food and Commercial Workers, Local 21 is described as:

All regularly scheduled full-time and part-time professional, technical, service/maintenance, business office, and medical records employees employed by Jefferson Healthcare, excluding supervisors, confidential employees, temporary and per diem employees, students, registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, and all other employees.

3. All proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in the selection of whether they wished to be represented by United Food and Commercial Workers, Local 21 in its existing bargaining unit. A confidential cross-check of employer and union documents has been conducted by Commission staff and a tally of the results previously furnished to the parties is attached hereto, and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.

4. The existing bargaining unit represented by United Food and Commercial Workers, Local 21 shall be modified to include the security employees for a bargaining unit described as:

All regularly scheduled full-time and part-time professional, technical, service/maintenance, business office, medical records, and security employees employed by Jefferson Healthcare, excluding supervisors, confidential employees, temporary and per diem employees, students, registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, and all other employees.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The unit described in Finding of Fact 4 is an appropriate unit for the purpose of collective bargaining within the meaning of RCW 41.56.060.
- 2. All conditions precedent to a certification have been met.

CERTIFICATION

The security employees at Jefferson Healthcare have chosen

UNITED FOOD AND COMMERCIAL WORKERS, LOCAL 21

as their representative for the purpose of collective bargaining with their employer.
