### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. The International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 1747 filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission a petition concerning representation of employees of the Puget Sound Regional Fire Authority. The petition was timely filed and accompanied by a showing of interest administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient.
- 2. These representation proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in the bargaining unit described as:
  - All full-time and regular part-time non-emergent medical providers (resident nurses and ARNPs) employed by Puget Sound Regional Fire Authority, excluding supervisors, confidential employees, and all other employees.
- 3. All proceedings were conducted in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in the selection of a bargaining representative, if any; a tally of the results previously furnished to the parties is attached hereto; and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.

# CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The unit described in Finding of Fact 2 is an appropriate unit for the purpose of collective bargaining within the meaning of RCW 41.56.060.
- 2. All conditions precedent to a certification have been met.

# **CERTIFICATION**
