#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. The Burlington-Edison Coaches Association filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission a petition concerning representation of employees of the Burlington-Edison School District. The petition was timely filed and accompanied by a showing of interest administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient.
- 2. These representation proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in the bargaining unit described as:

All coaches or advisors for WIAA recognized athletics and activities at Burlington-Edison School District, excluding supervisors, confidential employees, and positions for which educational certification is required.

3. All proceedings were conducted in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in the selection of a bargaining representative, if any; a tally of the results previously furnished to the parties is attached hereto; and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The unit described in finding of fact 2 is an appropriate unit for the purpose of collective bargaining within the meaning of RCW 41.56.060.
- 2. All conditions precedent to a certification have been met.
