FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Washington Federation of State Employees filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission a petition concerning representation of employees of the Washington State Department of Ecology. The petition was timely filed and accompanied by a showing of interest administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient. No other organization is known to claim to represent the employees involved.
- 2. These representation proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in the bargaining unit described as:

All Washington Conservation Corps Supervisors at the Department of Ecology, excluding nonsupervisors, WMS employees, and all other employees.

3. All proceedings were conducted in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in the selection of a bargaining representative, if any; a confidential cross-check of employer and union documents has been conducted by Commission staff and a tally of the results previously furnished to the parties is attached hereto; and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The unit described in finding of fact 2 is an appropriate unit for the purpose of collective bargaining within the meaning of RCW 41.80.070.
- 2. All conditions precedent to a certification have been met.

CERTIFICATION

The employees of the Washington State Department of Ecology in the appropriate bargaining unit described in finding of fact 2 have chosen

as their representative for the purpose of collective bargaining with their employer.
