FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Washington Federation of State Employees filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission a petition concerning representation of the food service supervisor 2 employees at the University of Washington Medical Center. The petition was timely filed and accompanied by a showing of interest administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient. No other organization is known to claim to represent the employees involved.
- 2. The existing bargaining unit represented by the Washington Federation of State Employees is described as:

All full-time and regular part-time custodial supervisors at the University of Washington and Harborview Medical Center and food service supervisors, excluding food services supervisors at the Harborview Medical Center and the UW Medical Center, and excluding confidential employees, nonsupervisory employees, and all other employees.

3. All proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in the selection of whether they wished to be represented by the Washington Federation of State Employees in its existing bargaining unit. A confidential cross-check of employer and union documents has been conducted by Commission staff and a tally of the results previously furnished to the parties is attached hereto, and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.

4. The existing bargaining unit represented by the Washington Federation of State Employees shall be modified to include the food service supervisor 2 employees for a bargaining unit described as:

All full-time and regular part-time custodial supervisors and food service supervisors in Seattle at the University of Washington including University of Washington Medical Center (UWMC) and Harborview Medical Center (HMC), excluding food services supervisors at HMC, and excluding confidential employees, nonsupervisory employees, and all other employees.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The unit described in finding of fact 4 is an appropriate unit for the purpose of collective bargaining within the meaning of RCW 41.80.070.
- 2. All conditions precedent to a certification have been met.

CERTIFICATION

The food service supervisor 2 employees at the University of Washington Medical Center have chosen
