FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Geoff Kristianson filed with the Public Employment Relations Commission a petition concerning representation of employees of Spokane County. The petition was timely filed and accompanied by a showing of interest administratively determined by the Commission to be sufficient.
2. The Washington State Council of County and City Employees is the incumbent labor organization that represented the petitioned-for employees and was granted status as intervenor in these proceedings.
3. These representation proceedings were conducted under the supervision of the Commission in the bargaining unit described as:

All deputy prosecutors of the Spokane County Prosecuting Attorney's Office; excluding paralegals, interns, the civil division, the chief criminal deputy, the county prosecutor, and all other employees of the employer.
4. All proceedings were conducted in a manner designed to afford the affected employees a free choice in the selection of their bargaining representative, if any; a tally of the results previously furnished to the parties is attached hereto; and no meritorious objections have been filed with respect to these proceedings.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The unit described in finding of fact 3 is an appropriate unit for the purpose of collective bargaining within the meaning of RCW 41.56.060.
2. All conditions precedent to a certification have been met.

CERTIFICATION

The employees of Spokane County in the appropriate bargaining unit described in finding of fact 3 have chosen

NO REPRESENTATION

as their representative for the purpose of collective bargaining with their employer.
