FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Washington Federation of State Employees filed a representation petition concerning employees of the Washington Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction. The Public Employment Relations Commission (PERC) determined the petition was timely filed and accompanied by a sufficient showing of interest. No other organization claimed to represent the employees involved.
2. The bargaining unit is described as follows:

All nonsupervisory employees in the Network Operations and Technology Support Center at the Washington Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction, excluding supervisors, WMS, confidential employees, and all other employees.
3. Because the more than 50 percent showing of interest threshold was met, PERC conducted card check proceedings. The employees were given a free choice in the proceedings. The tally of results was provided to the parties. No meritorious election objections were filed.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The unit described in finding of fact 2 is an appropriate unit within the meaning of RCW 41.80.070.
2. Representation proceedings were conducted in accordance with RCW 41.80.135 and chapter 391-25 WAC.
