FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Teamsters Local 760 filed a representation petition concerning employees of the City of Sunnyside. The Public Employment Relations Commission (PERC) determined the petition was timely filed and accompanied by a sufficient showing of interest. No other organization claimed to represent the employees involved.
2. The bargaining unit is described as follows:

All full-time and regular part-time employees of the City of Sunnyside in the following job classes: Administrative Services, Human Resources Manager, Human Resources Generalist, Community & Economic Development, Deputy City Clerk/Executive Assistant, City Clerk/Communications, Public Works Director, Deputy Public Works, Administrative Assistant to Public Works Director, Information Technology Manager, Information Technology Specialist, and Administrative Assistant to Police Chief, excluding confidential employees, and all other employees.
3. Because the more than 50 percent showing of interest threshold was met, PERC conducted card check proceedings. The employees were given a free choice in the proceedings. The tally of results was provided to the parties. No meritorious election objections were filed.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The unit described in finding of fact 2 is an appropriate unit within the meaning of RCW 41.56.060.
2. Representation proceedings were conducted in accordance with RCW 41.56.095 and chapter 391-25 WAC.

CERTIFICATION

City of Sunnyside employees in the bargaining unit described in finding of fact 2 have chosen

TEAMSTERS LOCAL 760

as their representative for the purpose of collective bargaining with their employer.
