### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Teamsters Local 117 filed a representation petition concerning the Traffic Signal Technicians at the City of Auburn. The Public Employment Relations Commission (PERC) determined the petition was timely filed and accompanied by a sufficient showing of interest. No other organization claimed to represent the employees involved.
- 2. The existing bargaining unit, last certified in *City of Auburn*, Decision 4880-A (PECB, 1995), represented by the Teamsters Local 117 is described as follows:

All full-time and regular part-time employees of the City of Auburn in the following departments and/or divisions: Building Maintenance, Custodians, Cemetery, Equipment Rental, Golf Course, Parks Maintenance, Sanitary Sewer, Streets, Vegetation, Water, and Storm Drainage, excluding supervisors, confidential employees, and all other employees.

- 3. Because the more than 50 percent showing of interest threshold was met, PERC conducted card check proceedings. The employees were given a free choice in the proceedings. The tally of results was provided to the parties. No meritorious election objections were filed.
- 4. The existing bargaining unit represented by the Teamsters Local 117 shall be modified to include the Traffic Signal Technicians for a bargaining unit described as follows:

All full-time and regular part-time employees of the City of Auburn in the following departments and/or divisions: Building Maintenance, Custodians, Cemetery, Equipment Rental, Golf Course, Parks Maintenance, Sanitary Sewer, Streets, Vegetation, Water, and Storm Drainage, excluding supervisors, confidential employees, and all other employees.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The unit described in finding of fact 4 is an appropriate unit within the meaning of RCW 41.56.060.
- 2. Representation proceedings were conducted in accordance with RCW 41.56.095 and chapter 391-25 WAC.

### **CERTIFICATION**

City of Auburn Traffic Signal Technician employees in the bargaining unit described in finding of fact 4 have chosen

#### **TEAMSTERS LOCAL 117**

as their representative for the purpose of collective bargaining with their employer.
